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INTRODUCTORY

This compilation containing the Appropriation Accounts of the Government of Sikkim for the year 1975-76 presents the accounts of sums expended during the period 26th April 1975, when Sikkim became the 22nd State of the Indian Union, to 31st March 1976 compared with the sums specified in the schedules appended to the Appropriation Acts passed under Articles 204 and 205 of the Constitution of India.

In these Accounts—

- 'O' stands for original grant or appropriation.
- 'S' stands for supplementary grant or appropriation.
- 'R' stands for reappropriations, withdrawals or surrenders sanctioned by a competent authority.

Charged appropriations and expenditure are shown in italics.
