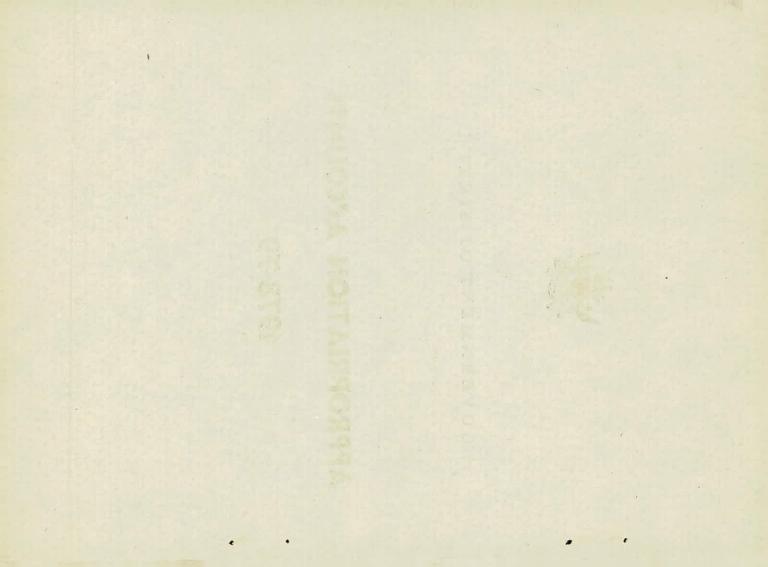

#### INTRODUCTORY
