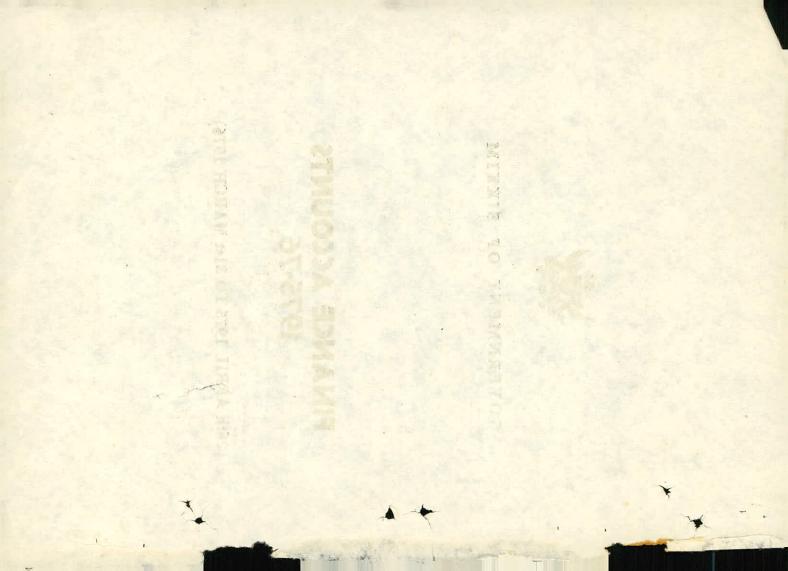

This compilation containing the Finance Accounts of the Government of Sikkim for the year 1975-76 presents the accounts of the receipts and outgoings of the Government for the period from 26th April 1975, when Sikkim became a State of the Indian Union, to 31st March 1976 (referred to as the year 1975-76 in this compilation) together with the financial results disclosed by the revenue and capital accounts, the accounts of public debt and liabilities and assets as worked out from the balances recorded in the accounts. The Appropriation Accounts of the Government for the same period for Grants and Charged Appropriations, presented separately, supplement this compilation.

These accounts have been prepared and examined under my direction in accordance with the requirements of Articles 149 and 151 of the Constitution of India and the Comptroller and Auditor General's (Duties, Powers and Conditions of Service) Act, 1971. Subject to the observations in this compilation and to those in my Report on the accounts of the Government of Sikkim for the period from 26th April 1975 to 31st March 1976, the accounts now presented are, according to my information, correct statements of the receipts and outgoings of the Government of Sikkim for the period 26th April 1975 to 31st March 1976.

INTRODUCTORY

Under the Constitution (Thirty-sixth Amendment) 1975, Sikkim became a State of the Indian Union from the 26th April 1975 and from that date, the Consolidated Fund and the Public Account of the State came into being under Article 266 of the Constitution. A Contingency Fund was also established by an Act of the State Legislature passed in October 1975, in terms of Article 267 (2) of the Constitution.

Prior to 26th April 1975, the transactions of the erstwhile Government of Sikkim were grouped under two sections, the first consisting of developmental expenditure financed entirely from grants or loans received from the Government of India and the second one consisting of normal expenditure met from the resources raised by the Government of Sikkim as well as from the grants and loans from the Government of India. The developmental expenditure was classified under sectoral heads for the purpose of rendering periodical statements of such expenditure to the Government of India. The normal receipts and expenditure were classified under certain Major Heads prescribed by the then Government. In either of the two sections, no distinction was maintained between revenue and capital expenditure, nor any distinction made between 'charged' and 'voted' expenditure.

During the period 26th April 1975 to 30th September 1975, when the expenditure of Government was covered by two authorisations by the Governor issued in May, 1975 and July, 1975, the accounting pattern previously followed was retained except that distinctions were introduced for the first time between revenue and capital expenditure and between charged and voted expenditure. In the budget for the year 1975-76, covering the period 26th April 1975 to 31st March 1976, presented to the Legislature in September 1975, the normal and the developmental budgets were unified into one statement and the classification of the transactions followed by other States of the Indian Union was adopted. The receipts and expenditure for the period upto 30th September 1975, initially classified under the old heads of accounts, were reclassified under the corresponding new heads of accounts.

2. The accounts of Government are kept in three parts:

Part I Consolidated Fund

Part II Contingency Fund

Part III Public Account

In Part I, there are two main divisions, viz:

(1) Revenue — consisting of sections for 'Receipt Heads (Revenue Account),' and 'Expenditure Heads (Revenue Account).'

(2) Capital, Public Debt, Loans, etc. — consisting of sections for 'Receipt Heads (Capital Account)', 'Expenditure Heads (Capital Account)', and 'Public Debt, Loans and Advances etc.'

First division: The first division deals with the proceeds of taxation and other receipts classed as revenue and the expenditure met therefrom, the net result of which represents the revenue surplus or deficit for the year.

Second division: In this division, the section 'Receipt Heads (Capital Account)' deals with receipts of capital nature which cannot be applied as a set-off to capital expenditure.

The section 'Expenditure Heads (Capital Account)' deals with expenditure met usually from borrowed funds with the object either of increasing concrete assets of a material and permanent character or reducing recurring liabilities. It also includes receipts of a capital nature intended to be applied as set-off against expenditure.

The section 'Public Debt, Loans and Advances, etc.' comprises loans raised and their repayments by Government such as 'Internal Debt' and 'Loans and Advances' made (and their recoveries) by Government. The section also includes certain special types of heads for transactions relating to 'Transfers from the Consolidated Fund to the Contingency Fund' and 'Inter-State Settlement'.

In Part II of the accounts are recorded the transactions connected with the Contingency Fund set up by Government in October 1975 under Article 267(2) of the Constitution of India.

In Part III of the accounts, the transactions relating to 'Debt' (other than those included in Part I), 'Deposits', 'Advances', 'Remittances' and 'Suspense' are recorded. The transactions under 'Debt', 'Deposits' and 'Advances' in this part are those in respect of which Government incurs a liability to repay the moneys received or has a claim to recover the amounts paid, together with the repayments of the former ('Debt' and 'Deposits') and the recoveries of the latter ('Advances'). The transactions relating to 'Remittances' and 'Suspense' in this part embrace all heads which are merely adjusting heads under which appear such transactions as remittances of cash between the bank and departments of Government. The initial debits or credits to these heads will be cleared eventually by corresponding receipts or payments.

3. Sectors and Heads of Accounts—Within each of the sections in Part I mentioned above the transactions are grouped into sectors, such as 'Tax Revenue', 'Non-Tax Revenue', etc., for the receipt heads (revenue account), and 'General Services', 'Social and Community Services', 'Economic Services', etc., for expenditure heads. Specific functions or services (such as education, medical aid, family planning, housing, etc., in respect of

Social and Community Services) are grouped in the sectors for expenditure heads. In Part III also the transactions are grouped into sectors, such as 'Small Savings', 'Provident Funds' etc., and 'Reserve Funds', etc. The sectors are subdivided into major heads of account. In some cases the sectors are, in addition, subdivided into sub-sectors before their division into major heads of account.

The major heads are divided into minor heads, each of which has a number of subordinate heads, generally known as sub-heads. The sub-heads are further divided into detailed heads. Under each of these heads, the expenditure is shown distributed between charged and voted. Sometimes major heads are also divided into sub-major heads before their further division into minor heads. The sectors, major heads, minor heads, sub-heads and detailed heads together constitute a five-tier arrangement of the classification structure of Government Accounts. The major, minor and sub-heads prescribed for the classification of expenditure in the general accounts are not necessarily identical with the Grants, subheads and other units of allotments which are adopted by the Finance Department for Demands for Grants; but in general a certain degree of correlation is maintained between the Demands for Grants and the Finance Accounts.

The major heads of accounts, falling within the sectors for expenditure heads, generally correspond to functions of Government, while the minor heads, subordinate to them, identify the programmes

undertaken to achieve the objectives of the function represented by the major head. The schemes or activities included in the programme generally correspond to sub-heads below a minor head representing a programme. Detailed heads give the object classification.

4. Codification—The sectors are distinguished by capital letters of alphabet in separate series for (i) receipt major heads (revenue account), (ii) expenditure major heads (revenue account) and (iii) capital section, public debt, loans and advances and public account. The sub-sectors are distinguished by small letters of the alphabet.

Each major head is allotted a code number which consists of a three digit Arabic number code. The first digit indicates whether a particular major head pertains to the 'Revenue Receipt' section/'Revenue Expenditure' section/'Capital Receipt' section/ 'Capital Expenditure' section/ 'Public Debt and Loans and Advances, etc.' section or to the 'Public Account'. The next two digits indicate the major heads. The digits indicating the major heads remain the same for the major head denoting the same function occurring in the several sections included in the Consolidated Fund.

Under this scheme of codification, the receipt major heads (revenue account) are assigned a block of consecutive serial numbers from 020 to 199, expenditure major heads (revenue account) from 211 to 399, expenditure major heads (capital account) from 411 to 599, major heads under 'Public Debt' from 601 to 610, and those under 'Loans and Advances', 'Inter-State Settlement' and 'Transfer to Contingency Fund' from 611 to 799. The code number 400 has been assigned for capital receipt major head. The only major head 'Contingency Fund' in "Part II — Contingency Fund' has been assigned the code number 800. The major heads in the Public Account are assigned the code numbers from 801 to 899.

- 5. The transactions included in these accounts represent mainly the actual cash receipts and disbursements during the period from 26th April 1975 to 31st March 1976 as distinguished from amounts due to or from Government during the same period. The cash basis system is, however, not entirely suitable for recording the transactions and presenting the true state of affairs of Government commercial undertakings run on commercial principles. The detailed accounts of this class of undertakings are, therefore, maintained outside the regular accounts in proper commercial form and are subjected to test check by the Indian Audit and Accounts Department.
- 6. The figures of actuals shown in these accounts are net, after taking into account the recoveries, although the Demands presented to the Legislature and the Appropriation Accounts are for gross expenditure and exclude all credits and recoveries which are otherwise taken as reduction of expenditure.

7. Under the system of accounts followed in Sikkim prior to its becoming a State of the Indian Union from 26th April 1975, no distinction was maintained between capital and revenue expenditure and the progressive figures for the capital expenditure on the various projects and schemes were not available either in the accounts or in the departmental records. Therefore, the figures of capital expenditure incurred from 26th April 1975 onwards alone are shown in this compilation. Similarly, the opening balances under the Debt, Deposits and Remittance heads as on 26th April 1975 could not be worked out from the accounts, the figures adopted in this compilation as opening balances in some of these cases being based on the information collected from departmental records.

Explanatory Notes

Under an arrangement made from the year 1968-69, the State Bank of Sikkim, established in that year, has been vested with the responsibility of receiving money on behalf of Government, making all Government payments and keeping custody of the balances of Government in current account as well as in fixed deposits that may be made from time to time. The transactions of Government in the districts are also made through the branches of the bank, except in one district in which a firm carrying on the business of banking among other things, functioned as an agent of the State Bank of Sikkim, by being authorised upto 1975-76 by the Bank to accept monies on behalf of the Government and also to make payment of cheques issued by Government departments. The balance held with the State Bank of Sikkim on 31st March, 1976 amounted to Rs. 88.15 lakhs.

Government also hold a part of their balances (Rs. 3.62 lakhs) in current accounts with two other banks, one in Calcutta (Rs. 2.92 lakhs) and the other in New Delhi (Rs. 0.70 lakh).

- 2. The cash balance represents the combined balances of the Consolidated Fund, Contingency Fund and Public Account.
- 3. The balance under the head "Remittances in transit" represents the amounts remitted by the Public Works Department to the Bank towards the end of the year, which have not been credited to Government account before the close of the year.
- 4. The investments held in the Cash Balance Investment Account were partly in fixed deposits with the State Bank of India (Rs. 3.17 lakhs) and with the State Bank of Sikkim (Rs. 314.74 lakhs) and partly in the Government of India securities (Rs. 7.27 lakhs). Interest realised during the year on investment of cash balances was Rs. 33.05 lakhs.
- 5. Details of investments out of earmarked funds are given in Statement No. 18.

Explanatory Notes

1. The significance of the term 'Government Account' is explained in Note 3 below.

The other headings in this summary take into account the balances under all account heads in Government books where Government has a liability to repay the moneys received or has a claim to recover the amounts paid and also heads of account opened in the books for adjustment of remittance transactions. It must be understood that these balances cannot be regarded as a complete record of the financial position of the Government of Sikkim as it does not take into account all the physical assets of the State, such as lands, buildings, communications, etc., nor any accrued dues or outstanding liabilities which are not brought to account under the cash basis of accounting followed by Government. The balances in the Provident Fund accounts of Government servants and investment made out of such balances have been kept out of Government Account, vide note in Statement No. 6 on page 32 and Appendix on page 120.

- 2. A summary of receipts, disbursements and balances under Debt, Contingency Fund and Public Account is given in Statement No. 15.
- 3. Government Account: Under the system of book-keeping followed in Government accounts, the amounts booked under revenue, capital and other transactions of Government, the balances of which are not carried forward from year to year are closed to a single head called "Government Account". The balance under this head represents the cumulative result of all such transactions so that after adding thereto the balances under Public Debt, Loans and Advances, Reserve Funds, Deposits and Advances, Suspense and Miscellaneous Remittances and

Contingency Fund, the closing cash balance at the end of the year may be worked out and proved. The Government Account for 1975-76 given below will show how the net amount at the end of the year has been arrived at:
